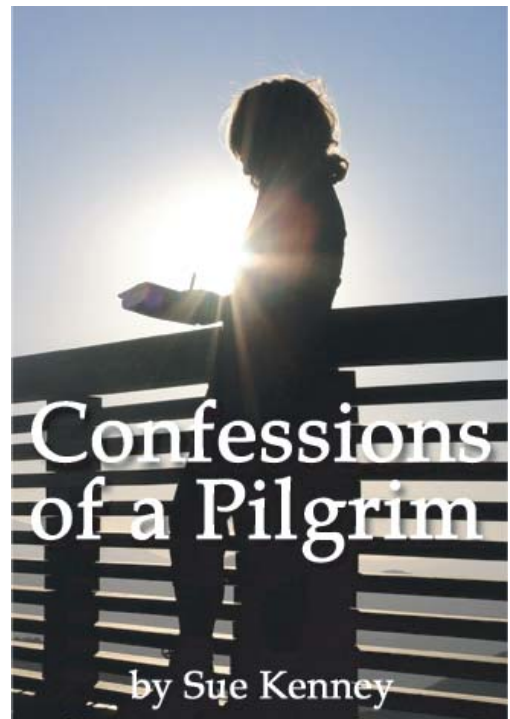
The Power of Voice
